That the City Council go on record congratulating Police Officer James J. Ford on the occasion of his retirement, and be it further

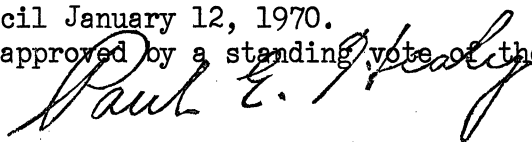
RESOLVED:-
