To The Honorable, The City Council:

Attached is an order requesting the appropriation of \$1,096,643.00 in the Grant Fund from the U.S. Department of Health & Human Services to the Human Services Department Salary & Wages Account \$86,422.00 and Other Ordinary Maintenance Account \$1,010,221.00 to provide funds for the Low Income Energy Assistance Program to Cambridge and Somerville households with incomes of up to 175% of the Federal poverty level. Direct benefits range from \$85 to \$550 per household depending on eligibility. Last year the program served 3,403 households of which 1,362 were in Cambridge.
