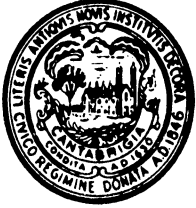

To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$890,000 to the Public Investment Fund Community Development Department Extraordinary Expenditures Account. The funds are being used to construct sidewalks, streets and other public improvements in the Kendall Square Urban Renewal area. These improvements have been reviewed and approved by appropriate City department, the Bicycle Committee and the Pedestrian Committee. For the purpose of this grant the City of Cambridge is acting as a "pass-through" and an agreement by and between the City of Cambridge and the Cambridge Redevelopment Authority is being executed.

The Redevelopment Authority is supervising all work activities and will administer the grant funds. The funds to support this appropriation will come from the State Department of Housing & Community Development.
