To The Honorable, The City Council:

Attached is an order requesting the appropriation of an additional \$535,358.00 in the Grant Fund from the U.S. Department of Health & Human Services to the Human Services Department Salary & Wages Account \$18,628.00; Other Ordinary Maintenance Account \$516,620.00; and Travel & Training Account \$110.00. This appropriation is for additional funds for the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) which the Department of Human Services operates under the Cambridge/Somerville Fuel Assistance program which provides financial assistance for heating costs to households with incomes of up to 175% of the Federal poverty level. Direct benefits range from \$85 to \$550 per household depending on eligibility. The total funding for this program from October 1, 1991 to September 30, 1992 is now \$1,472,298.00.
