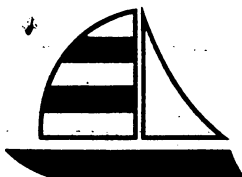

The New England Mariners Baseball Club is an organization associated with the New England Association of the Amateur Athletic Union (AAU) of the United States. The AAU/USA Junior Olympics, founded in 1948, has consistently been one of the largest and most successful programs of its kind in the world of amateur athletics.

The program consists of over 20 Olympic sports with several age classifications, allowing America's youth the opportunity to compete in regional and national tournaments. The Junior Olympics program also teaches youngsters the importance of setting goals, and striving to achieve and exceed those goals.

Over the past six years the New England Mariners have won four National Titles and three Bronze Medals, and are currently recognized as one of the most successful AAU/Junior Olympic Baseball programs in the country. To date, a number of their players have signed baseball scholarships with prestigious colleges and universities, and they have had six players sign with Major League Baseball.

In 1997, the New England Mariners are organizing five teams, ages 13-17, to compete nationally in August. The following baseball player has been named to the New England Mariners 15 year old team for the 1997 season. The Mariners will be competing regionally this spring and summer to earn a bid to the National Championship in Memphis, Tennessee.
