- WHEREAS: Robert "Bobby" Hunter, a native Cantabrigian, began his employment with the MDC in 1960 as a Patrol Officer and after training in local district assignments was transferred to MDC Revere Station where for most of his law enforcement career he patrolled the beaches and the district of Revere protecting life and property; and
- WHEREAS: During his thirty year tenure Officer Hunter served as the Selective Enforcement Officer in Revere, as representative for the Revere District for his union and was Coach-Player for the MDC Police Softball Team; and
- WHEREAS: His love of sports and children drew him to become active in the North Cambridge Little League where people looked to him as a role model, guardian and protector; and
- WHEREAS: Bobby along with being a citizen advocate and an intense observer of politics in Cambridge through his life always making his positions on various issues known to the local legislative body, also found time to be a member of the French Club of Cambridge and the Cambridge Lodge of Elks #839; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record expressing its gratitude to Officer Robert J. Hunter for his dedication to law enforcement and to express its good wishes for continued good health and happiness as he retires from active duty; an event which will be celebrated by his many friends, family and colleagues at the Veteran of Foreign Wars Post 8818 on Friday, October 12, 1990; and be it further
