

Authorization is requested for funds transfer of \$940 for travel expenses. This amount is needed to supplement the \$391 currently available. These funds are federal monies, and the travel has been recommended and approved by the grantor agency, the Committee on Criminal Justice. Additional travel funds are requested for attendance at the seminars described below by the Crime Analyst and the Juvenile Program Coordinator, respectively. Cost: \$770

- B. Attendance at the 1977 National Institute on Crime and Delinquency in Salt Lake City, Utah, June 18-21, 1977. The seminar will focus on all facets of the criminal justice system, and with specific emphasis on juvenile delinquency.
Cost: \$560

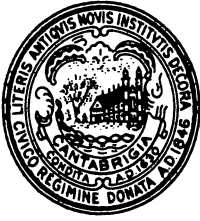


