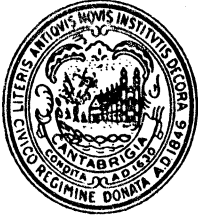

Dear Mr. Healy,

I have viewed the proposed driveways at the intersection of Concord Avenue and Smith Place and find that the developers of this lot have taken my suggestion and created a one way system whereby traffic would enter from Concord Avenue and exit onto Smith Place. This will eliminate most of the conflicts associated with this type of operation.

As I stated to the Board of Zoning Appeals, given the data submitted by the developer, I recommend that these driveways be approved with the stipulation that the exit driveway on Smith Place be 25 feet in width so as to conform to the law.

The undersigned respectfully prays that a driveway for commercial use may be constructed and agrees to deposit with the City Treasurer the sum of seventy five (\$75.00) dollars, subject to the following conditions, to wit: In case the amount so deposited is in excess of the cost of the driveway, the difference shall be refunded by the City Treasurer, but in case the cost of the driveway exceeds that deposit, said deposit shall be applied as a credit to the bill and the balance shall be paid to the City Treasurer within thirty days from the receipt of the bill.

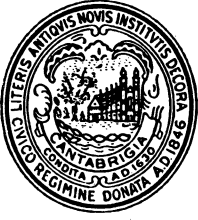
