WHEREAS: While black smoke invaded the building it was virtually impossible for the victims to see themselves to safety and because of the quick thinking of many of the buildings occupants as well as public safety officials the injury list was minimal however it is still not without tragedy one man did not survive; and

WHEREAS: There are many heroes during those hours of panic the actions of all public safety officials, ambulance attendants and others offering mutual aid have to be singled out; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council go on record offering its sincere thanks and debt of gratitude to all who relieved the panic and ensured the workers of One Broadway their safety; and

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and is hereby requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the suitable parties on behalf of the entire City Council.
