PHASE II:

* Comprehensive air quality testing, soil gas testing, soil borings and analysis. Air quality testing and monitoring should remain as a long term recommendation.

Note: Composite sampling and analysis is to be avoided. Sampling gathering, testing, and lab analysis equipment should be purged and cleaned regularly. Equipment, and equipment filters should be replaced as needed in order to ensure accurate and reliable information. Sampling and testing should be done under optimum weather conditions. E.g., soil gas testing should occur during warm, dry weather at a time when the soil is not saturated with moisture. The worst time to do soil gas testing would be in the winter or early spring when the weather is cold and the soil is saturated with moisture.

PHASE III:

- * comprehensive sediment and surface water sampling and analysis.
- * Additional soil borings and analysis.
- * Comprehensive epidemiological and basement flooding studies of the Clifton Street, Whittemore Ave., and Rindge Ave. neighborhoods (to include streets and locations associated with those neighborhoods).

Note: See note for Phase II.

PHASE IV:

* Observation wells to be installed for short and long term monitoring. The observation wells would include single shallow wells and nested wells. Locations for these wells would include but are not limited to Seagrave Rd. @ Alewife Brook Parkway, Whittemore Ave., Gibbons Park, the Community Gardens on Whittemore Ave., the Clifton St. edge of Russell Field, the Grace Site edge of Russell Field behind the bleachers, the Grace Site edge of Russell Field near the north end zone, and Linear Park near Harvey & Clifton Streets.

Note: See note for Phase II.

PHASE V:

* Color coded mapping of contaminated areas, conclusions, identification of responsible party or parties, remedial recommendations, and identification of additional funding sources as needed.

Note: Phase V should be ongoing throughout Phases I, II, III, & IV.
