

CHAPTER 310--1971

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE FUNERAL AND BURIAL EXPENSES OF FIRE FIGHTERS AND POLICE OFFICERS KILLED IN THE PERFORMANCE OF DUTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Chapter 41 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 100F, inserted by chapter 613 of the acts of 1970, the following section:-

Section 100G. Any city operating under Plan D or Plan E charter, by the affirmative vote of a majority of all the members of its city council, any other city, by a majority vote of its city council with the approval of its mayor, and any town, by a majority vote at an annual or special town meeting, shall pay the reasonable expenses, not exceeding two thousand dollars, of the funeral and burial of any fire fighter who while in the performance of his duties and as a result of an accident while responding to or returning from an alarm of fire or while at the scene of a fire is killed or sustains injuries which result in his death, or of any police officer who while in the performance of his duties and as a result of an assault on his person is killed or sustains injuries which result in his death. The provisions of this section shall become effective in a city or town when accepted by such city or town, and, if accepted prior to January the first, nineteen hundred and seventy-two, shall apply to deaths occurring on or after January the first, nineteen hundred and seventy, otherwise only to deaths occurring after its acceptance by such city or town.

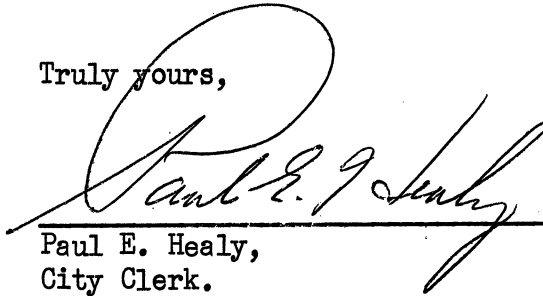
