Dear Ms. Pupa :

I met with you on July 12, 1988 to discuss the letters the Cambridge Housing Authority recieved from the City of Cambridge Traffic Dept. At this meeting we discussed your letter and your concerns with people parking in the Corcoran Park (tenant parking only) lot that abuts your property. You stated at this time cars park in front of your entrance way and you donot have access to enter your gate as there is no sidewalk. On these issues I have taken the following action.

Steve Harper, Security, CHA will check out the CHA parking lot for illegal cars parked. I will monitor the lot on a daily basis. I have contacted the Cambridge Tow Co. and will be contracting them to tow all cars that do not have a CHA resident sticker, between the hours of 11 P.M. and 8:30 A.M. Any other vehicles parked illegally will be towed as necessary on a daily basis. The contract should be in effect on or before July 22, 1988 as I have tonotify all tenants.

I have contacted Mrs. Jean DePasquale in the Mayors office and I explained your concerns about the parking on May Street and asked her to have some one check out that area and possibly assist you in getting a no parking sign in front of your house. Mrs. DePasquale stated she would look into the matter and requested I send her copies of the corospondance I have recieved. I mailed her the copies today.

I hope that the above action will help to address the problems you have had. Feel free to contact me if I canbe of any assistance in the future.

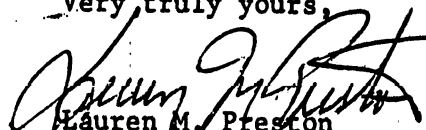

many times, I have also gotten letters from Mr. Wrenschel but the problem hasn't been solved after so many years it is getting worse.

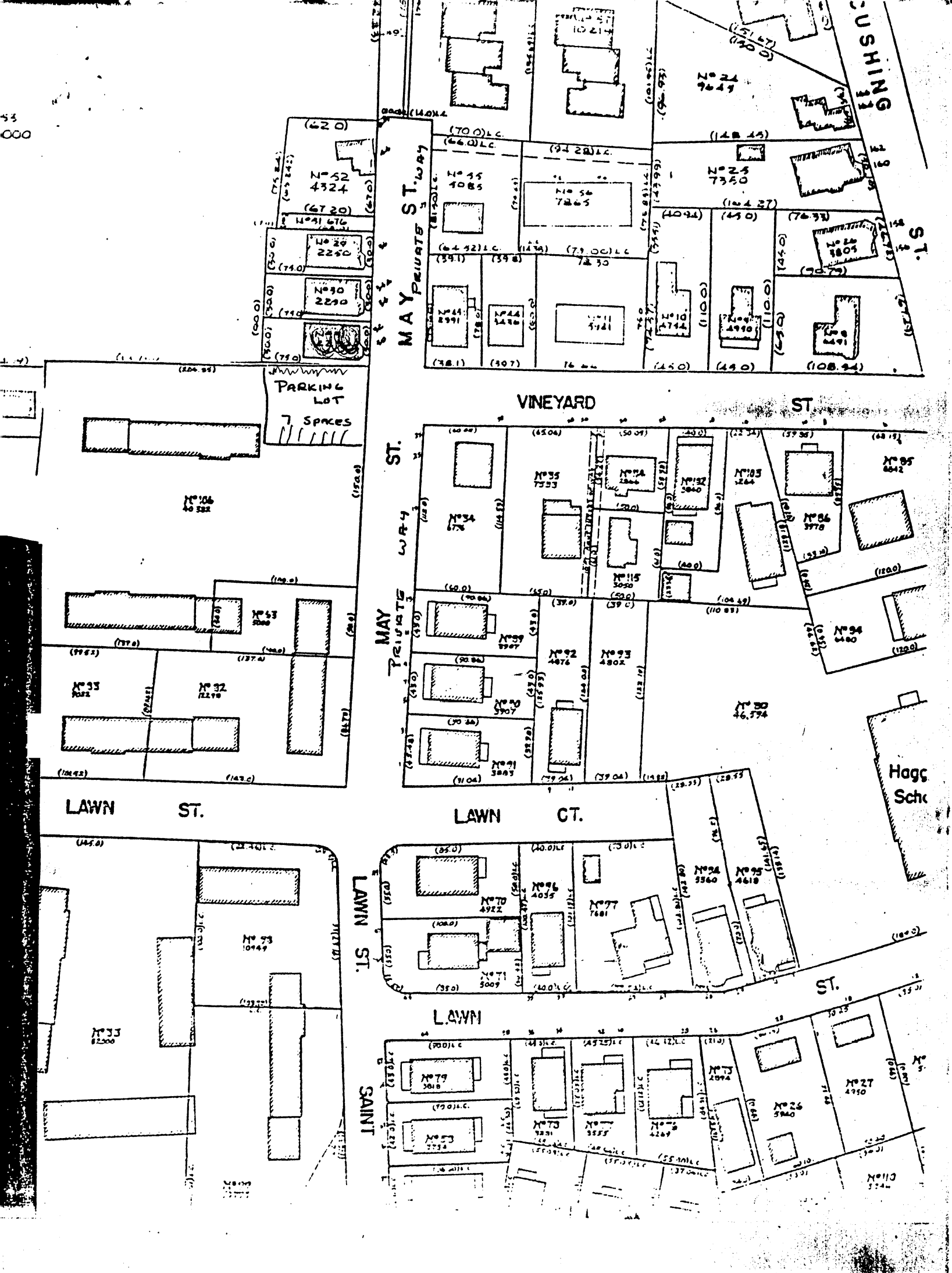
I would like you to recommend me to someone in regards in solving this matter, there driveway should be made private just for the people who live in (1-8 unit)
