The Commission requests that the appropriate City authority grant it permission to use this property on August 3rd or on the scheduled raindate, August 4th from NOON till 6PM.

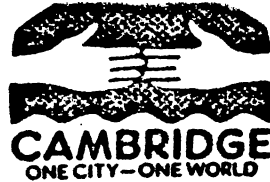
