- WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened upon learning of the passage of Charles L. Hinkson, at the age of 90; and
- WHEREAS: Born in Barbados, West Indies, Mr. Hinkson arrived in Boston aboard the "Vestres" on June 3, 1916 and was a resident of Cambridge ever since with a year's absence in 1918 to serve in the British Army, Fifth Worshester Regiment; and
- WHEREAS: On June 4, 1916, Mr. Hinkson was hired at Lever Brothers where he would serve for 43 years as a top-notch mechanic and machinist with a near-perfect record of never late, never absent attendance, unequaled productivity and recognized innovative improvements in manufacturing equipment; and
- WHEREAS: Mr. Hinkson married Jeswene Othelia Waithe in 1920 and is survived by five children, twenty-two grandchildren, nineteen great grandchildren and four great-great grandchildren, all who loved and respected him and will miss him very much; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED That this City Council go on record extending their sincere sympathy to the entire Hinkson Family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to prepare a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to be presented to the Hinkson Family on behalf of the entire City Council.
