- WHEREAS: The money for this type of project would generally be provided from either the water rates or general obligation bonds; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to institute a program allocating 25% of the water rates collected from property owners and water users for the reconstruction of the physical plant of the Water Department.
