- WHEREAS:** It has come to the attention of this City Council that Lieutenant James H. Sullivan has retired from active duty on the Cambridge Fire Department, and
- WHEREAS:** Lieutenant Sullivan was first appointed a firefighter on November 21, 1937 at which time he was assigned to Ladder Company 3 where he remained until May 15, 1943 at which time he was transferred to Ladder Company 1, and
- WHEREAS:** Firefighter Sullivan was promoted to the rank of Lieutenant on August 1, 1948 and was briefly assigned to Engine 5 prior to being transferred to Engine 3 on September 12, 1948, Engine 7 on January 1, 1950, Engine 1 on July 11, 1954 and to Engine 9 on September 21, 1973 the Engine Company from which he retired, and
- WHEREAS:** Lieutenant James H. Sullivan has served this City and protected the well being of its residents for 40 years as a member of the Cambridge Fire Department, now therefore be it
- RESOLVED:** That this City Council go on record extending our sincere gratitude to Lieutenant James H. Sullivan for his dedication to duty and to further extend to him our very best wishes for a healthy and happy retirement, and be it further
- RESOLVED:** That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to prepare for presentation a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution on behalf of the entire City Council.
