WHEREAS:

They provide excellent visibility from a distance, valuable crowd and traffic control, an excellent means of patrolling the parks and shopping areas as well as the neighborhoods, and

WHEREAS:

The public reception of this program has been truly outstanding, and

WHEREAS:

The City of Boston has indicated a preliminary willingness to assist us in an initial training program using their mounted patrol facilities in Jamaica Plain, therefore be it

ORDERED:

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to consult with the Chief of Police and report back to this Council within two weeks with a response to the proposal of instituting a pilot mounted police program in the City of Cambridge.
