Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge as follows:

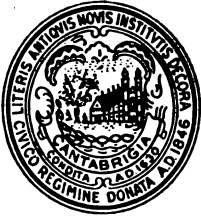

To the Honorable, the City Council:

I wish to advise your Honorable Body that I am consolidating the two Veterans departments of the City of Cambridge in accordance with the recommendations to me of Charles N. Collatos, Commissioner of Veterans Services for the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

I have designated this date Pasquale L. Reale as Director of the Veterans Services and Benefits Department for the City of Cambridge, pursuant to the provisions of the General Laws of the Commonwealth. Mr. Walter DeGuglielmo will be Mr. Reale's Assistant in this Department.

I wish to further advise your Honorable Body that both Mr. Reale and Mr. DeGuglielmo had lateral responsibilities and with an identical pay scale. I now recommend, subject to your favorable consideration, a change in the ordinance as it relates to the pay scale for Mr. Reale, as follows:

On Page 1 of the Classification Plan, Executive Administrative Salaries established by Ordinance, July 1, 1973 -

Change: Director of Veterans Services, Salary \$15,810 minimum to \$17,310 maximum, with annual increment of \$500.

To: Director of Veterans Services and Benefits,
Salary \$18,280 minimum to \$19,780 maximum, with
annual increment of \$500.
