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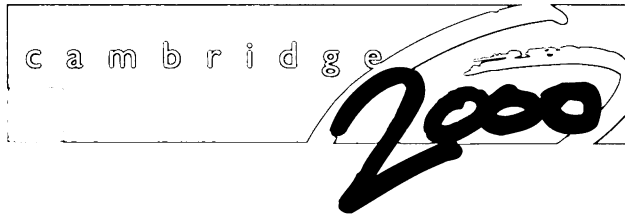

To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting an appropriation of \$12,685 in the Grant Fund of the Human Services Salary and Wages Account (\$880) and Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$11,805). The Massachusetts Department of Revenue, through the Department of Housing and Community Development has awarded funds to the Low-Income Sewer and Water Assistance Program to help support Cambridge and Somerville homeowners, whose income falls at or below 150% of poverty according to Federal guidelines. Eligible clients can receive benefits toward their annual water and sewer bills.
