IN CITY COUNCIL

June 8, 1981

WHEREAS: Aeneas Casey, a former employee of the Police Department of the City of Cambridge, entered the service of the Police Department on March 1, 1929 and was pensioned on June 14, 1943 under the provisions of Chapter 32, Section 57 of the General Laws and died on March 10, 1981, having served not less than fourteen years; and

WHEREAS: At the time of his death said employee had no rights to elect that benefits be paid to his survivor, said employee leaves as his survivor, his widow, Mrs. Stacia Casey, who has not remarried and is not receiving any retirement allowance or pension under the provisions of any general or special law, therefore be it

ORDERED: That, under the provisions of Chapter 32, Section 95A of the General Laws, Tercentenary Edition and amendments thereto, that in order to promote the public good, and in consideration of the long and meritorious service performed by Aeneas Casey, an annuity be granted to Mrs. Stacia Casey, widow of Aeneas Casey, of \$3,000.00 per year as long as she does not remarry.

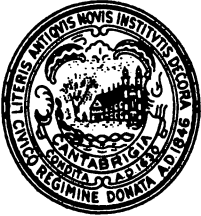
Dear Mr. Sullivan:


