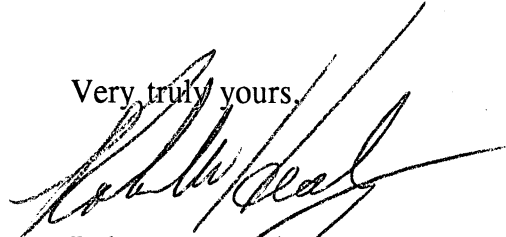
To The Honorable, The City Council:
