- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that John J. Molloy, Vice-President for Public Relations at Commonwealth Energy System of Cambridge will retire from the company, completing thirty-two years of service, effective May 1, 1985; and
- WHEREAS: John served his country well during World War II as a member of the United States Army and saw action in the European Theatre, participating in campaigns on Bougainville and in the Philippines; and
- WHEREAS: John, upon being honorably discharged, held positions with the Greater Boston Community Fund and the Boston Chamber of Commerce, prior to joining Commonwealth Energy in 1953 as a Public Relations Specialist, where, having majored in journalism at Boston University, he put his strong expertise of the newspaper, radio and television medium to work; and
- WHEREAS: John rose through the company ranks, being named Assistant Vice-President of Public Relations in 1967 and became Vice-President in 1974, establishing, directing and implementing the functions and policies directly related to public information and public affairs for all subsidiary companies of Commonwealth Energy System; and
- WHEREAS: Among his many civic interests, John is a Founder and past President of the Publicity Club of Boston, a member of the Edison Electric Institute Public Relations Committee and former chairman of the Army Advisory Committee on Public Relations for the 1st U.S. Army, he has also served as Vice-President of the United Cerebral Palsy Association; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its sincere best wishes for continued good health and happiness to John J. Molloy as he enters a new phase of his life with his wife Betsy, four children and five grandchildren; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to John on behalf of the entire City Council.

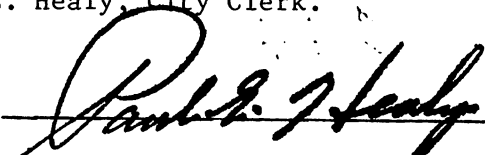
