- WHEREAS: The Archdiocese of Boston will soon lose an experienced administrator and devoted clergyman, in the person of Bishop Thomas V. Daily, Auxiliary Bishop of Boston and Vicar General of the Archdiocese, who has been appointed by the Holy Father, Pope John Paul II to head the new Diocese of Palm Beach, Florida; and
- WHEREAS: Bishop Daily, a Belmont native, attended Saint John's Seminary and was ordained into the priesthood on January 10, 1952 and received his first assignment as a Parish Priest at Saint Ann's, Wallaston, an assignment he held until 1960 at which time he joined the Missionary Society of Saint James the Apostle, a Society founded by the late Richard Cardinal Cushing; and
- WHEREAS: Having completed five years of missionary work in Peru, Father Daily returned to this country and to Saint Ann's in 1971 and was chosen by the late Cardinal Medeiros to serve as his Personal Secretary and Master of Ceremonies; and
- WHEREAS: In 1973, Father Daily was appointed Chancellor of the Archdiocese and on February 11, 1975, he was ordained an Auxiliary Bishop of Boston, and upon the death of the late Auxiliary Bishop Thomas J. Reilly, he was also named Vicar General, and from September 17, 1983 to March 23, 1984 he served as Administrator of the Archdiocese after the sudden death of the late Humberto Cardinal Medeiros, posts he has held with distinction and served with tireless dedication; and
- WHEREAS: The loss of Bishop Daily to the people of Boston and the Archdiocese as a whole is a true gain to the people of the new Florida diocese; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deep appreciation to Bishop Thomas V. Daily for his countless good deeds and tireless efforts on behalf of the people of the Archdiocese in general and to the residents of Cambridge in particular, and to further extend all God's blessings to him that he may enjoy good health and happiness as he administers to his new flock; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Bishop Thomas V. Daily on behalf of the entire City Council.

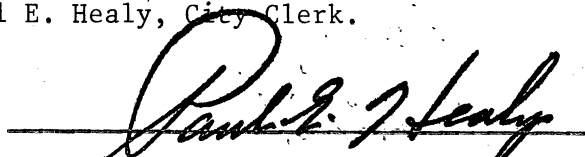
