An Ordinance in amendment of an
Ordinance in relation to streets.

Be it ordained by the City Council
of the City of Cambridge, as follows,

Section seventeen of Chapter twenty-five
of the Revised Ordinances, is hereby
amended by adding after the word
"situated" in the tenth line thereof, the
words, "No person thus licensed shall
act thereunder until he has filed with
the City Clerk a bond with sufficient
surety, satisfactory in amount to the Mayor
and said Aldermen, to indemnify the
City from all loss and damage by reason
of said removal."
