Dear Mr. Sullivan,

At the original budget hearings for the fiscal year 74/75, my Traffic Signal Maintenance Account was reduced by \$25,000.00. This money was requested to cover the cost of repairing traffic signals damaged or knocked down by motor vehicles. At that time I was told that if these accidents did occur that I could come back for an additional appropriation to cover these costs.

As of April 30, 1975, there have been a total of 44 accidents involving traffic signals at a total cost of \$31,009.94.

Claims have been filed with the owners' insurance companies in the amount of \$17,312.77 which will be put into the General Fund.

Vehicles owned by the City of Cambridge have been responsible for \$2,608.78 worth of damage to our traffic signals which we will not be reimbursed for and the Police Department have no records of the other accidents totaling \$11,394.39 and we must therefore assume these as hit and run accidents.

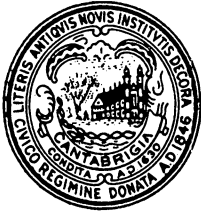
I respectfully request that an additional appropriation of \$32,000.00 from the Parking Fund to the Traffic and Parking Department F-3 Account so that we can pay these bills.


