As Product Manager with NASA's Jet Propulsion Laboratory for the Mars Pathfinder mission, Brian Muirhead assembled a team that would have to build a spacecraft and land it on Mars for one-twentieth the cost and in half the time of the previous Mars effort twenty years earlier. Experts who were sure the team could not succeed joined the worldwide celebration on July 4, 1997, when Pathfinder landed safely on Mars and, aided by its self-propelled, toy-wagon-size rover, Sojourner, began sending back reams of scientific data and thousands of breathtaking color photographs.

For this achievement, he was awarded NASA's Outstanding Leadership Medal. He was named Engineer of the Year for 1997 by Design News magazine and 1997 Laureate for Space by Aviation Week & Space Technology magazine.

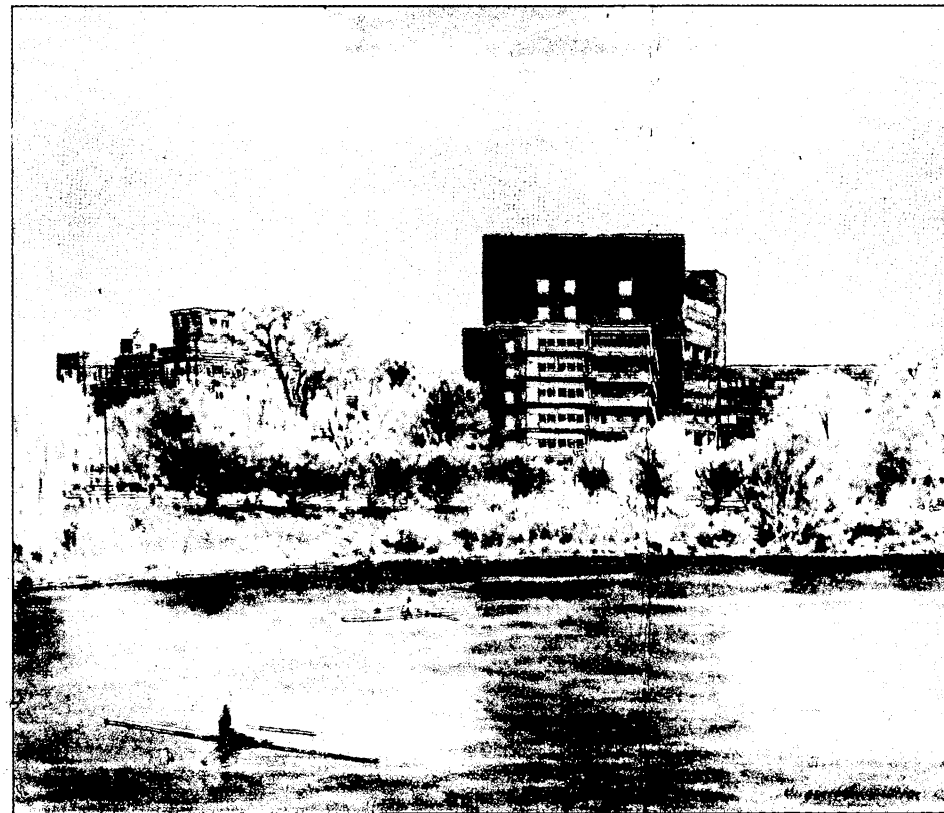
