It has come to the attention of this City Council that William L. Brodman, will soon retire from practicing general medicine in the City of Cambridge since 1946; and

A medical staff member of the Mt. Auburn Hospital, the Cambridge Hospital, the Sancta Maria Hospital, and the Quigley Memorial Hospital, Dr. Brodman came to Cambridge to practice with Dr. Jacob Rudd, following three years of military service during World War II, Medical Corps U.S. Army; and

WHEREAS:

In his early years of practice, Dr. Brodman provided many voluntary community services such as running the well-baby clinic at the Agassiz School, examining for the Cambridge YMCA, and responding to the numerous requests of the clergy throughout the city; and

WHEREAS:

Dr. Brodman also served two terms as State Department Surgeon A.M.V.E.T.S. for the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and now holds memberships with the Massachusetts Medical Society - Middlesex South, the Medical Society, Freedom Lodge A.F. and A.M., and the Oakley Country Club; and

WHEREAS:

Dr. Brodman who is married to Sylvia Stone Brodman, is the father of Steven, Kenneth, and Lois Brodman Casassa, and the grandfather of four, plans to continue as a staff physician in the out-patient department at the Soldier's Home in Chelsea; therefore, be it

That this City Council go on record extending its sincere appreciation and gratitude to Dr. Brodman for his complete dedication and service to Cambridge residents throughout the years and to further extend every good wish for continued good health and happiness in the years ahead; and be it further
