ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to confer with the Director of the C.E.T.A. Office to ensure that an appropriate number of C.E.T.A. position be made available at the property located at 1221 Cambridge Street in order to provide twenty-four hour per day security for the elderly residents of this building; and be it further

ORDERED: That any assignment of security guards be done in conjunction with the management company for the building, Abrams Management, Inc., the Police Chief and the Tenants Council within the building; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to confer with the Council on Aging and the Committee on Elders, Inc. in order to ensure that both organizations provide the appropriate advisory assistance to the elderly at 1221 Cambridge Street at work with the management of the building; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager provide some kind of emergency assistance in terms of security, immediately, for the elderly residents of the building while negotiations continue regarding permanent security guards.
