WHEREAS: It appears that the Police Department traffic officers are too few in the morning rush hour and have completed their work at the afternoon rush hour; now therefore be it

ORDERED: The City Manager be and hereby is requested to look with the Chief of Police at the issues around traffic safety that arise because the schedules of officers assigned to traffic duty and to revise this schedule, it appropriate, to increase traffic safety measures; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to report back to the Council on the measures that have been taken.
