- ORDERED:** That it is the desire of the City Council to move forward with options to keep additional shelter beds available over the summer as long as the need exists; and be it further
- ORDERED:** That the City Manager is hereby requested to investigate all avenues for maintaining the shelter at the First Congregational Church and/or other shelters, including seeking funds from the Department of Public Welfare.
