WHEREAS: After a quick assessment, Firefighter Devlin determined that the patient was without a pulse and not breathing. He immediately placed the patient on the floor and performed CPR until the arrival of the Westwood Fire Department; and

WHEREAS: Firefighter Devlin's rapid, skilled, and selfless actions resulted in the victim making it to the hospital with a pulse and a blood pressure; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record congratulating Firefighter/Paramedic Hugh Devlin for his quick thinking and unselfish actions; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and is hereby requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Hugh Devlin on behalf of the entire City Council.
