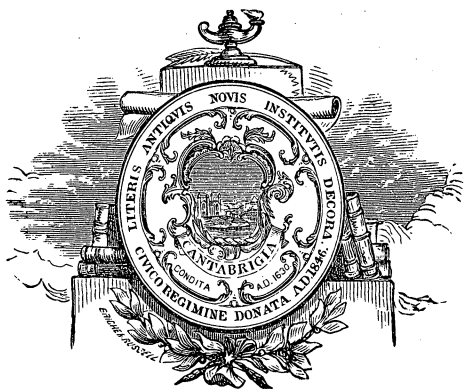




CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

IN BOARD OF ALDERMEN,

Nov 10. 1885.

WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that

*Grigg Street, from New Street,
so-called to a point about seventy feet
easterly,*

should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land

*Forty feet
in width between said New Street and a
point about seventy feet easterly*

included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid,

*the owner thereof having waived the usual
notice of such taking and agreed to claim no
damages therefor.*
