WHEREAS:

Philias Lange, a former employee of the Public Works Department of the City of Cambridge, entered the service of the Public Works Department on September 8, 1930 and was pensioned on October 24, 1962 and died on February 9, 1973, having served not less than thirty-two years, and

WHEREAS:

At the time of his death said employee had no rights to elect that benefits be paid to his survivor, said employee leaves as his survivor, his widow, Mrs. Justine Lange, who has not remarried and is not receiving any retirement allowance or pension under the provisions of any general or special law, therefore be it

ORDERED:

That, under the provisions of Section 95A of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, Tercentenary Edition and amendments thereto, that in order to promote the public good, and in consideration of the long and meritorious service performed by Philias Lange, an annuity be granted to Mrs. Justine Lange, widow of Philias Lange, of \$1,500.00 per year.

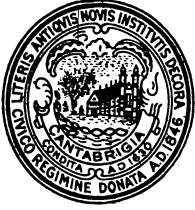

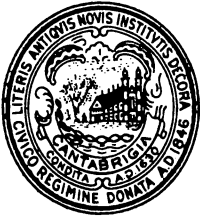


