That Superintendent's Recommendation #89-153, FY'89-90 Revised Budget and C.R.L.S. Administrative Reduction, be adopted in its entirety as follows: that the School Committee approve the following revisions for the FY'89-90 General Fund Budget:

1. An amended budget for FY'89-90 of \$65,189,425 be adopted as originally approved by the School Committee on March 23, 1989, consistent with the appropriation amount approved by the City Council.
2. Approve the following alternative to the FY'89-90 C.R.L.S. administrative reductions previously adopted by the School Committee, in accordance with the School Committee order dated March 23, 1989, authorizing the Superintendent to bring back to the Committee for consideration any alternative administrative reductions proposed by the C.R.L.S. administrator which have the same financial effect as the adopted reductions and which the Superintendent finds acceptable:
 - a. Replace the previously approved C.R.L.S. administrative reduction of three assistant house administrators with the reduction of one Cambridge Rindge and Latin School house with the same financial impact, with the following positions and benefits being reduced:

1.0 FTE House Administrator	(\$ 52,976)
1.0 FTE Assistant House Administrator (temporary)	(49,322)
1.0 FTE Full time Clerk (re-assign)	(23,343)
1.0 FTE Part time Clerk (re-assign)	(15,525)
Benefits for four staff positions	(27,200)
Total	(\$168,366)
Original Reduction	(168,366)
Balance	0

Further, that the C.R.L.S. administration immediately begin to develop an implementation plan for this house consolidation, and report back through the Superintendent to the School Committee on its progress.

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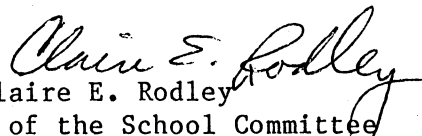
