WHEREAS: In the past years, the City Solicitor's budget has contained ever-increasing requests for monies to be set aside for outside counsel; and

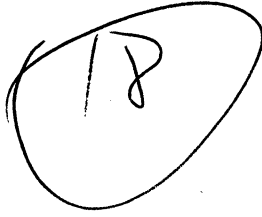
WHEREAS: This City Council is the guardian of the taxpayer's money; and

WHEREAS: The City Manager is the chief executive of this City and many of the decisions that have subsequently led to litigation, should be decisions where he has the final word; and

WHEREAS: The City Manager is hired and fired by the City Council and appears before the City Council at all of its regular meetings and can seek the advice of the Council when he deems necessary; now therefore be it

ORDERED: If and when the City Manager and/or the City Solicitor deems it necessary to hire outside counsel, that the City Council be notified by the City Manager and that where the City Manager deems it appropriate that said notification contain his recommendation that such outside legal counsel be named a special employee of the City and further all notification should contain a detailed explanation as to how that particular firm was selected and their hourly rate.
