Subject Proposed City Council resolution
on U.S. Military action in Grenada

Pursuant to the City Council's referral of the subject resolution to this department for review and report by the Cambridge Veterans' Organization (CVO), I met with the CVO on November 15th and read the proposed resolution to that organization.

The Cambridge Veterans' Organization states unanimously that it rejects the proposed resolution strenuously and is unalterably opposed to its adoption.

The Cambridge Veterans Organization further states unanimously that it gives whole-hearted support to the position taken by President Ronald Reagan which has the endorsement of the Speaker of the House of Representatives, Thomas P. O'Neill.
