The Board at its meeting on July 21, received several orders and beg to report as follows;

An order dated May 18, 1937, relative to communicating with the Metropolitan District Commission in regard to placing white beach sand at Magazine Beach, and providing sand boxes for children under the trees. A communication has been sent the District Commission expressing your wishes.

An order dated June 29, 1937, relative to additional benches at Broadway Common. A project has been written under the W.P.A. which includes construction of concrete benches at the Common.

An order dated June 22, 1937, asking consideration of construction of a comfort station at Broadway Common. This has been laid on the table for future action.

An order dated May 18, 1937, relative to oiling Cambridge Field. The field has been oiled since submission of this order.

An order dated May 18, 1937, naming the municipal golf course The Patrick J. Delaney Course. This name has been adopted.
