- 1962 - Assigned to the Fire Group full time, working for Al Fraser and later for Robbie Meshan.
- 1978 - Appointed Supervisor of Fire/Safety Group.
- Miscellaneous - Has received numerous letters of appreciation - commendations from both Faculty members, Department Heads, ect. Also in 1982, received recognition from Director for completing eleven (11) years of perfect attendance.
