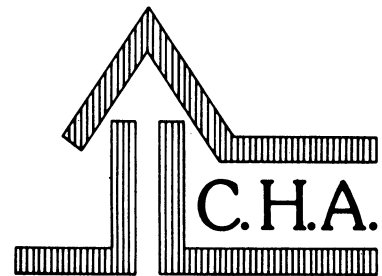

Dear Mr. Sullivan:

The Cambridge Housing Authority wishes to go on record concerning City Council Order No. 10 of July 10, 1978 regarding the naming of the Tower Building at Roosevelt Towers for Ms. Clorae Evereteze. At its regularly scheduled meeting of July 12, 1978 the C.H.A. Board entertained a request made by the Roosevelt Towers Task Force in this regard. At that time similar request incorporated in the above-referenced City Council order was made known to the C.H.A. Board of Commissioners. Accordingly, the C.H.A. passed unanimously the following resolution:

"That the Tower Building at Roosevelt Towers, once successfully rehabilitated and reoccupied, should be named the Clorae Evereteze Building to honor the recently deceased founder and President of the Roosevelt Towers Tenant Council."

It is obvious that it is the desire of all parties who knew and worked with Ms. Evereteze that her accomplishments at and her dedication to Roosevelt Towers, public housing and low-income people be appropriately recognized. I trust that there is no question regarding the Authority's intent in this matter.

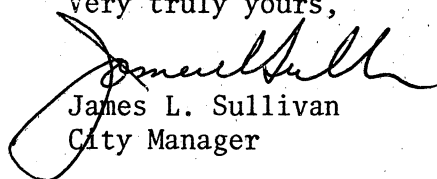
