- WHEREAS: Some Cambridge residents lease cars or their companies lease, cars for them, on a long-term basis; and
- WHEREAS: The procedure for getting resident parking stickers for these residents is very difficult, time-consuming and annoying; and
- WHEREAS: It is understandable that the Traffic Department needs some verification that the person using the leased car is a Cambridge resident, eligible for the parking sticker; therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager is hereby requested to review the process established for parking permits when residents are driving cars leased for them and to simplify it for the resident by requiring readily available proof of residence or affirmation of their ownership by signature on pains of penalty for perjury or whatever process would be less cumbersome; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager is requested to report back to the City Council the results of this review.
