ORDERED: That the City Manager, with all deliberate speed, begin an examination of the feasibility of purchase by the City of Cambridge of the U.S. Department of Transportation Building in Kendall Square, or other suitable site within the City of Cambridge.

The purpose of this study is to determine whether it would be cost effective for the City to own said building in order to consolidate the operations of several City Departments therein, thereby lessening the amount of rent being paid out presently for the utilization of commercial properties, while simultaneously providing greater ease of access to the citizens of Cambridge in their dealings with various City Departments.
