- WHEREAS: The parking lot of the Nabisco Brands Inc. Plant, located on the corner of Columbia Street and Bishop Allen Drive is presently the object of complaints from neighbors and plant employees; and
- WHEREAS: In the past, Nabisco has allowed neighbors to use the parking lot in the evenings. However, in recent days, complaints have been received revolving around inappropriate behaviour; excessive noise and loud music; verbal harassment of passers-by; "car repair" on junked automobiles in the parking lot.
- ORDERED: That the City Manager, with the Chief of Police examine the situation thus described and beef up surveillance and police presence in the area of the parking lot as one means of alleviating what is at worst a hazard and at best, an unjust nuisance to the neighborhood; and be it further
- ORDERED: That a remedial response to the above concern be transmitted to this Council at the Council Session on June 22, 1987.
