1. Get well to Mr. Cardullo

2. that the CM transmit to the City Council a plan for notifying out of town bicyclists about the enforcement of bicycle laws, for example how will those bicyclists from Arlington who pass through Cambridge on Mass. Ave. be informed that bicycle laws will be enforced. *here.*

3. Whereas bicycle helmets save lives,
That the CM contact Harold Cox and the Health of the City to ask for their support in providing a bicycle helmet subsidy or "prescription" program for Cambridge students, similar to the program in Boston and some other communities.

4. Whereas the MBTA is contemplating many changes to Cambridge bus service, Whereas a hearing is scheduled at a location that is not accessible by public transportation and is not centrally located,

That the CM contact the MBTA to request that an additional hearing be scheduled which is accessible by MBTA service, possible that the Senior Center or City Hall might be ^{more} available for such a meeting.

Further that with regard to future hearings that the MBTA be requested to confer with the CM prior to setting such hearings times and locations in order to maximize coordination between Cambridge citizens, city government and the MBTA and that in any case these hearings should be accessible by public transportation.

5. That the citizens be notified that Monday, November 10 that the MBTA will be holding a hearing on bus service changes at the VFW hall, 688 Huron Avenue, 7-9 p.m. HD

Further that service on the #74 bus to Huron Ave is proposed to be discontinued on Sundays

Also that service may be resumed on Broadway but it is not clear where the buses would stop

Also that there are numerous other changes.

That citizens are urged to attend
