Re: Alternate Day for Street Cleaning

(Also Council Order No. 11, April 9, 1984)

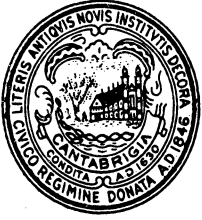
The Department of Traffic and Public Works have agreed upon a schedule for 1985 which should maximize our cleaning efforts while minimizing "lost" time and/or unclean streets. Basically, the Department will sweep every weekday from April 1, 1985 through November 30, 1985, with the exception of the following Federal Holidays:

Memorial Day	May 27th	- 4th Monday
Independence Day	July 4th	- 1st Thursday
Labor Day	September 2nd	- 1st Monday
Columbus Day	October 7th	- 1st Monday*
Veteran's Day	November 11th	- 2nd Monday
Thanksgiving Day	November 21st	- 4th Thursday

*Only on the first Monday do we have a situation that would apparently leave the first Monday uncompleted. In all probability, we will sweep on October 7th should conditions warrant the effort.

This would mean that out of a possible 175 days available during the eight-month period, we actually sweep, weather permitting, 170 days. As in the past, every attempt will continue to be made in areas effected by holidays, to sweep on the "spare days" at the end of the month, posting streets where necessary.
