Dear Mr. Healy:

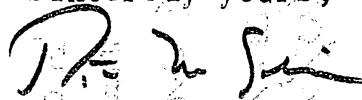

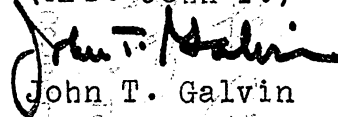
We are both voters of Cambridge.
