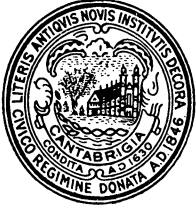

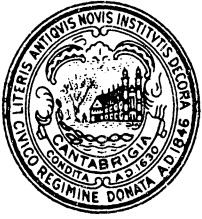
I hereby request an appropriation in the amount of \$304.57 to reimburse Anthony Celluck, an employee of the Public Works Department for damages in this amount.


To the Honorable, the City Council,
