Gentlemen:

Concerning the order of your board dated June 30th in reference to Plans of North Avenue from the Railroad Bridge to Arlington line, I hereby beg leave to report: that the necessary survey and levels have been made and a preliminary plot and profile is prepared for your inspection and action, to establish such lines and grades as the public convenience requires. When such action is complete I recommend that a sufficient number of stone bounds be immediately set so that their location may be shown on the sectional plans to be prepared for record.

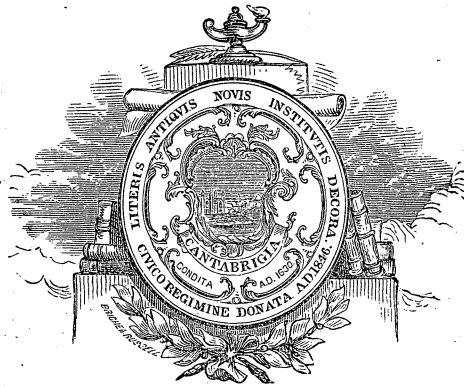

In Board of Mayor and Aldermen, *October 6th* 1869

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Board, the safety and convenience of the inhabitants require that *North Avenue, so called running from the Fitchburg Rail Road Bridge to Arlington line* should be *laid out anew, as a public way and described by lines, bounds, and monuments, that may be distinguishable* it is therefore hereby Ordered, that due notice be given to *the abutters on said Avenue and all other persons interested*

that this Board intends to *Lay out* *or Avenue* the Street before mentioned, by taking a portion of *their* land and laying out the same as a public street — and that *Wednesday* the *twentieth* day of *October, current* at 8 o'clock, P. M., is assigned as the time for hearing any objections which may be made thereto.
