The Committee on ^{Ordinances} Watering Streets, to which was referred an Order requesting ^{it} to consider the expediency of so amending the Ordinance in relation to Watering Streets, as to place the care of the Watering in charge of the Committee on Roads and Bridges,

Reports

That the Committee has fully considered the subject of the order, but does not find sufficient reason for disturbing the existing arrangements of the Committee on Watering Streets during the present season.

For Committee believes that it would be advantageous to the City, to have the personal supervision and control of the Street Watering in charge of the Superintendent of Streets, and while unwilling to interfere with the province of the Committee on Watering Streets, would respectfully recommend that said Committee employ the Superintendent

of Streets, as Superintendent of Watering.
