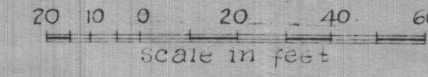
Pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 28, Regulation of Traffic - Article III, Section 4, Location of Bus stops, trackless trolley stops, taxicab stands and service zones. The Metropolitan Transit Authority is granted permission to extend the present bus stop on Massachusetts Avenue, Cambridge, at the Harvard College Yard gate, approximately forty (40) feet southeasterly and approximately sixty (60) feet northeasterly, and to establish a bus stop on Massachusetts Avenue, at Holyoke Street, extending approximately one hundred (100) feet easterly from the building line on the easterly side of said Holyoke Street. Permission is also granted to erect stanchions with signs reading, "Bus Stop - No Parking", at these locations.

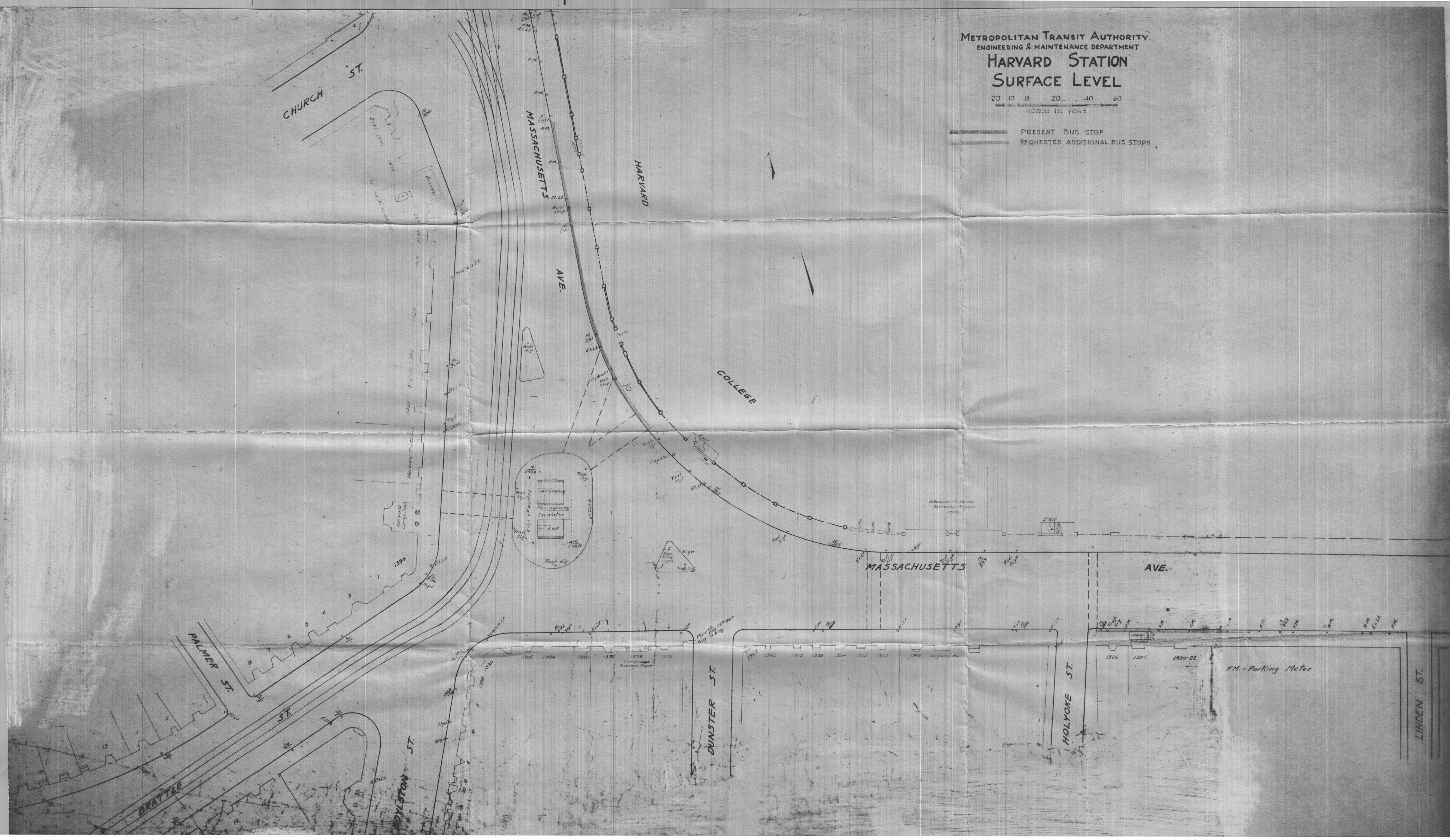
