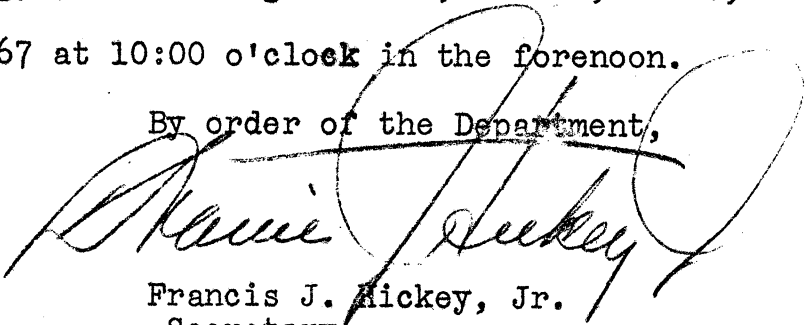

Investigation by the Department upon its own motion and pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 30A, Section 2 and Chapter 159, Section 16 of the General Laws, to determine the desirability and feasibility of the adoption of a Regulation by the Department requiring all railroads operating within the Commonwealth to install suitable warning systems at certain or all crossings at grade, designed to give adequate warning to trains approaching said crossings which may be obstructed.

Upon the foregoing investigation the Department of Public Utilities will hold a public hearing at its hearing room, 12th floor, State Office Building, 100 Cambridge Street, Boston, Mass., on Tuesday, November 21, 1967 at 10:00 o'clock in the forenoon.
